Rooted in our neighborhood, Rise Prep is a place where students and families of different communities, ethnicities, and socioeconomic status unite to grow academically, socially, and spiritually.

# A Proven Model



At the heart of all we do at Rise, is our Scholar Advocate Program. In order to be the school that we desire to be—to have 80% of our seats reserved for first-to-college, low-income and Bayview resident scholars—we need a financial model that increases equity and creates access to quality education for our families. On average, Rise families contribute 15% of tuition costs. The remaining 85% is covered by financial scholarships from generous Rise Advocates and partners. Our goal is to pair every scholar with a supportive Advocate who will provide a quarter, half, or full scholarship for the cost of education, and who will encourage them to their utmost.

# **Nathan & Cristian**

Nathan: I think for me, when I first learned about Rise Prep, it was compelling and interesting as sort of a vision of what a school could be, but it took on more life when I was paired with Cristian—to be able to see his growth and development over the years—so that when I think about Rise now, I think more about him than about an idea. It has helped me feel more invested in the school to know someone here.

Cristian: I would say Nathan is like an older brother because I don't have an older brother. It's just actual people who are supporting kids. I never had an idea of adults actually sponsoring a kid's education. I thought it was just companies and programs. For a soccer team, the sponsor is just like a name on our jersey. It's not an actual person. It's different to see an actual person more than just a name or logo on a jersey. I'm grateful for him advocating for me, but I don't want his help to end here. I want him to help sponsor another student after I graduate. I'm grateful. I just don't want the help to end here, and I want this to flourish into other students. I want other people to meet who he is.





# Financial Scholarship

#### **Tuition**

At Rise, 80% of our seats are reserved for low-income, first generation to college, or Bayview resident scholars. Each of our students receive scholarships that on average cover 85% of the cost of tuition in order to increase equity and access to quality education. Most independent and private schools in the Bay Area cost \$40,000 - \$60,000 each year. On average, Rise families pay 15% of tuition and the remaining 85% of student tuition is covered, thanks to the generosity of Rise Advocates.

## **Scholarships**

Our Advocates can provide scholarships for a Rise student at four different levels per year:

SCHOLARSHIP LEVEL	TOTAL	MONTHLY
Full Scholarship	\$20,000	\$1,667
Three-Quarters Scholarship	\$15,000	\$1,250
Half Scholarship	\$10,000	\$833
Quarter Scholarship	\$5,000	\$417

- Rise Advocates have the opportunity to commit to a one year scholarship or up to four years of scholarship for a student's full high school journey.
- Scholarship donations can be issued yearly, or split into smaller gift increments on a quarterly or monthly basis.
- Rise Prep is a 501(c)(3) non-profit. All gifts are tax-deductible.

## Individual and Group Advocacy

Consider becoming a Rise Advocate with your family, small group, coworkers, or friends. If giving a scholarship as a group, we do ask that you designate one or two members of your group to commit to relationally investing in the life of a Rise scholar.

#### A Relational Commitment

Our prayer and goal for each of our students is that they would know at least five adults that have championed them along the way to the finish line as future collegiate scholars. Just like our relationship with Jesus, and with the people in our lives, relationships require time and commitment if they are to flourish. Our hope is that this investment would look a lot like the sacrificial love and care Jesus has shown each of us. We ask our Advocates to consider what it looks like to commit to a mindset of mentorship and discipleship in becoming an Advocate.

#### Biographies

 Once matched, both our Advocates and scholars share short bios to get to know one another. Our Rise team will provide prompts to help you get started!

#### Letters

 Throughout the school year, our Advocates and scholars exchange pen-pal style letters. You can expect to receive and write letters three to four times a year.

#### Lunches

 Many of our Advocates find time to come by school during the year to grab lunch and catch up with their scholar.

#### College Essay & Personal Statement Workshops

 As students approach college application season, our Advocate community helps to revise and review personal statements and college essays.

#### Career Fairs

 Many of our Advocates volunteer to share about their own career paths or support with mock interviews and resume reviews.

#### • Extracurriculars & School Showcases

 Rise Advocates have the opportunity to support Rise athletics, arts programs, and department showcases, especially those in which their student participates.

#### Volunteering & Tutoring

 Rise offers opportunities for Advocates and community partners to volunteer at Rise events or provide tutoring in various subjects for students in need.
