



Job Description: 6th-10th grade Math/Science Teacher (1.0 FTE)

Organization Summary

Rise University Preparatory is an independent Christian school as an outworking of God's shalom.

Rooted in Bayview/Hunters Point, Rise Prep teaches whole students—equipping them with the tools they need to reason, create, serve, and lead; creating a space where students and families across communities, ethnicities, and socioeconomic situations unite to grow academically, socially, and spiritually.

Our goal is for 100% of our diverse scholars to be accepted into a four year university. Rise Prep's model is built on combining the power of a top-notch education with a committed long-term community to facilitate bright futures for each of our scholars and break long-held cycles of systemic injustice.

Rise is currently 9th-12th grade, but we are launching a middle school with a class of 6th graders for the fall of 2026-2027 and will add a grade level each year. We're looking for highly motivated, gifted middle school teachers who are ready to do what it takes to lovingly build a school from the ground up.

Job Summary

Full time Middle and High School Math/Science Teacher for 2026-2027. As a Christian role model and instructor, the Math/Science Teacher provides a strong academic foundation in math and science for the development of the student's full flourishing to honor God and one another; to grow in knowledge, skill, and virtue to reason, create, serve and lead in this world. Under the supervision of the Head of School, Math/Science Teacher plans, organizes and teaches an instructional program in a safe and positive learning environment that guides students to develop content knowledge and moral character in the following courses:

- 6th Grade Math
- 6th Grade Earth Science
- 10th Grade Algebra 2
- Homework lab
- Student support for success in the above courses



Essential Job Functions and Responsibilities

- Develops and maps out the course curriculum according to state standards and school standards for coherent and academically robust instruction; submits to Head of School for approval;
- In support of such approved curriculum, prepares and delivers clear instructional lesson plans and activities that engage students and that facilitate high academic growth towards college readiness;
- Identifies and provides various instructional resources, and methods and relevant technology that meet students' varying learning needs and that recognize their diverse cultural and socio-economic backgrounds and unique abilities;
- Assigns and grades class work, homework, assignments and various assessments in a timely manner; communicates clearly with students and families;
- Observes, encourages and evaluates students' performance and progress; maintains accurate and complete records of students' attendance, progress and development in the course;
- Maintains order and discipline in the classroom by establishing and enforcing rules and procedures in accordance with the rules and disciplinary systems of the school; establishes and maintains high standards for moral character development in accordance to school wide expectations (See Rise Prep's ESLRs.);
- Provides extensive support for student academic growth through office hours and tutoring; understands all students can succeed with motivation, persistence, and thoughtful scaffolding;
- Maintains positive and collaborative relationships with families, colleagues, administration, and community partners;
- Models Christian faith, responsibility, service, and professionalism;
- Performs other duties as assigned by the Head of school including four hours of supervision per week (eg, front desk, lunch or morning supervision), chaperones at least seven field trips;
- Participates in school fundraising efforts and neighborhood engagement; understands that fundraising provides 85% of the school budget;
- Chaperones 6th Grade Outdoor Education, an overnight 3 day trip.
- Attends and participates in weekly faculty meetings and a variety of professional development activities;
- Physical requirements: teachers need to be mobile—to rotate between classrooms with class materials for different courses. All teaching is in person only. Teachers need to be able to move about the classroom and project.

- Must possess the minimum qualification of a Bachelor of Science in a related field such as Mathematics from a recognized accredited college or university

- Must possess social emotional maturity and excellent communication skills to foster good relationships with students/families and between students as well
- Must be flexible and willing to serve where needed and take ownership of the development of the new middle school
